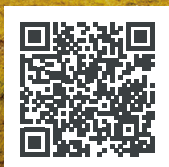

CAMPOREE LOCATION

The Camporee site is located roughly an hour from Christchurch airport and 30mins from Rangiora.

The Camporee address is 289 Taaffes Glen Road, Whiterock, Okuku Range.

There will be signage you can follow to direct you to registration.

APPLICATION FORMS

INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION FORM

Absolutely EVERYONE who is coming to Camporee needs to complete an application form, no one is exempt. You must complete the INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION FORM even if you are not a Pathfinder but are providing support for the club E.G. Club Directors, Counsellors and Cooks etc. Ensure you complete the medical information, emergency contact, consent and release information which must be completed and signed by ALL applicants.

CLUB APPLICATION FORM

This form needs to include the details of every single person from your club attending the Camporee (Pathfinders and Club support staff). Before filling it in we suggest you read the Instructions for Completing the Club Application Form.



ADSAFE & POLICE VETTING

(NEW ZEALAND CLUBS ONLY)

Anyone over 18 years of age attending Camporee must meet the AdSafe requirements. Refer to your application form for details. Applicants not meeting these requirements will not be allowed to attend.



AGE LIMITS

The minimum age of any attendee who is in a Pathfinder Club is 10 years of age.

Please note that Pathfinders are eligible to attend if they have turned 10 years of age by the first day of the Illuminé Camporee, January 8, 2019.

Underage children cannot be at Camporee. You will have to make other arrangements for their care. Please do not embarrass yourself or us by disregarding this request. We appreciate your cooperation on this matter.



CANCELLATION POLICY

It is Camporee Policy that there will be no refunds unless there is a cancellation due to a death in the immediate family. All requests must be accompanied with supporting documentation. Requests will only be considered after Camporee.



STAFF TO PATHFINDER RATIOS

The aim of the Illuminé Pathfinder Camporee is to provide our Pathfinder aged children (10-16 year olds) with a once in a lifetime opportunity to celebrate Pathfinding together. Therefore the top priority is to ensure that Pathfinder aged children attend. In order to achieve this as a priority each club needs to comply with the ratios between staff and Pathfinders. These ratios need to be enforced by the local Conference and Mission. The staff to Pathfinder ratio is approximately 20-25% adults to 75-80% Pathfinders.

CLUB LEADERS

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR CLUB

Every person in your club attending Camporee MUST fill in the Individual Application Form (IAF).

As you receive completed IAF Forms check that all sections have been completed correctly

When you have ALL your club's Individual Application Forms and are confident they have been filled in correctly and signed THEN complete a Club Application Form.

Submit your completed Club Application Form and the Individual Application Forms for each person in your club along with full payment for your Club to your local Conference/Mission.

CAMPOREE OPENING & CLOSING TIMES

Clubs will be allocated registration times between 8:00am and 2:00pm on Tuesday the 8th January, 2019. The Illuminé Pathfinder Camporee will officially start with the Opening Ceremony at 4:00pm on Tuesday January 8, 2019. It will conclude after the closing ceremony on Saturday night, January 12, 2019. Departure from the Camporee site will commence on Sunday morning the 13th January, 2019 no earlier than 7:00am. All clubs must leave the grounds before 2:00pm.





CAMPOREE FEE

A fixed currency rate has been applied for clubs using Pacific Francs.

CLOSED EVENT

After the Opening Ceremony and Parade, which parents or friends may attend, the Camporee will be a **CLOSED EVENT**. Only those who have registered and paid will be permitted on site during the Camporee. No one will be permitted to leave the Camporee site with the exception of medical emergencies. This is for your safety and to maintain the special atmosphere of the Camporee. The Security Officers will ensure that this rule is adhered to for the smooth-running of the event and your safety.

Clubs must plan ahead so they can be self-sufficient for all their needs during the Camporee. The site is in a rural area on a farm with no nearby facilities.

A store for Club cooks will provide perishable goods (including ice) on a daily basis.



MISSION CLUB STARTER PACK

Mission Clubs may choose to purchase a Starter Pack.

The order must be submitted with payment along with your Club Application Form at the latest by closing registration **Monday September 3**.

They can be collected upon arrival at either Pascoe Park or at Camporee registration.

PRE AND POST CAMPOREE ACCOMMODATION

We realise it is not always possible to arrange transport to coincide exactly with the start and end of a Pathfinder Camporee. With this in mind, the SNZ Conference have kindly made available the campground at Pascoe Park in Christchurch but you may also want to consider options such as public campgrounds.

Please be aware that if you choose to stay at Pascoe Park **you need to be self-sufficient for shelter and food etc.** There are shower and toilet facilities and a kitchen block but *tents will not be available*. If you are a Mission Club and ordered a Starter Pack then you can request to pick it up there. Accommodation is available at Pascoe Park for the following dates and fees:

- + **Pre camporee:**
Friday 4 Jan 2019 – Tuesday 8 Jan 2019
- + **Post camporee:**
Sunday 13 Jan 2019 – Wednesday 16 Jan 2019
- + **Rate per person:** NZD\$6 / XPF\$430

TRANSPORT TO & FROM CAMPOREE SITE

All Mission Clubs who require transport to/ from Christchurch airport and the Camporee site or to/ from Pascoe Park and the Camporee site are to complete the [TRANSPORT REQUEST FORM](#) and submit it along with the [CLUB APPLICATION FORM](#). This transport will be provided *free of charge to Mission Clubs* and is only available on January 8 and January 13.

NZ Clubs may also request this service but will need to pay NZD\$10 (per person each direction) and submit full payment along with the [TRANSPORT REQUEST FORM](#).

We cannot take any tentative bookings. All bookings must be accompanied by full payment.

We will not process any requests for transport after Monday Sept 3, 2018.

PARKING

There will be an allocated area for the parking of cars and buses etc. No vehicles will be allowed in your club camping area once the Camporee starts.

Clubs that are using cooking trailers will be able to have these as part of their camp set up. Please indicate whether your club has one of these on your Club Application Form.



GENERATORS

Generators will have curfews too. Clubs that plan to use generators to power their refrigeration or cookers should indicate the type of generator on their Club Application Form. Clubs will be camping in very close proximity to each other, so please respect your neighbours by being aware of noise and fumes from generators.



VISAS

If you require a visa to travel to New Zealand, please contact your local Youth Department to request an official Letter of Invitation.

PROHIBITED ON SITE



No one under 10 years old



No cutting down trees



No open fires



No alcohol, smoking or drugs



No pets



No bicycles



FIRE SAFETY

Each Pathfinder Club is responsible for its own fire safety procedures. Clubs must bring two buckets - one to be filled with water and the other to be filled with sand/dirt as well as a fire blanket near the cooking area at all times.

Note that one fire extinguisher will be provided for each sub-camp.

Do not take fire extinguishers on the plane.



PATHFINDER UNIFORM

Pathfinders need to be in full dress uniform at the Opening Ceremony on Tuesday the 8th of January and again on Sabbath morning the 12th of January. On other occasions your field uniform will be appropriate.



ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Please be aware that there is no access to electricity while at Camporee.

Therefore, recharging will be impossible. If you choose to bring electronic devices such as iPods, iPads, tablets, laptops and mobile phones, it is at your own risk. Remember, the campsite has no reception for mobiles or internet.



ATTENDANCE SOUVENIRS

A number of Camporee souvenirs (E.G. attendance patch, club pennant, pin and passport stamp) will be available. More information will be included in following Newsletters.





SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

All Pathfinder Clubs will need to be self-sufficient. You will need to bring/arrange for the following in addition to any other items you need:

CLUB

- + Tents (Sleeping & Cooking)
- + Enough food for your club until you collect your food order from the Camporee Store
- + Cooking Gear: Gas Cookers, Pots, Utensils (Remember gas or fire cylinders are not allowed on planes)
- + Buckets & Fire Blanket for fire safety
- + Wash up Basin and bio-degradable detergents
- + First Aid Kit
- + Camp Furniture (Minimal)
- + Plastic Garbage Bags for all club refuse (Place rubbish in bags, then in skip bins)
- + Ground Sheet/Mat for night programs
- + Solar showers (showers are not supplied)
- + Pathfinder Club flag and flag stand

INDIVIDUAL

Pathfinders will need to bring:

- + Bible
- + Pathfinder Passport (if you have one)
- + Pen or pencil
- + Plate, cup, cutlery, tea towel
- + Basic First Aid Kit
- + Toiletries (biodegradable soap, toothbrush, toothpaste etc.)
- + 2 or more towels
- + Sleeping Bag and/or sheet and warm blanket
- + Lilo/air mattress and/or sleeping mat
- + Pillow
- + Sun hat & sun cream
- + Torch & spare batteries
- + Insect repellent
- + Water Bottle



TRAVEL AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

All Camporee attendees are responsible for arranging their own Travel and Medical Insurance. Cancellation or loss of airline ticket/passport and the cost of medical treatment is expensive in New Zealand.

All items you bring are your responsibility.

CLOTHING

- + Pathfinder Dress Uniform
- + Field Uniform
- + Older clothes for wet/muddy activities
- + Jacket, jersey (it can be cold & windy at night)
- + Wet weather gear in case of rain (raincoat/poncho, gumboots)
- + Swimmers/togs - (girls-one piece and shorts or T-shirts and shorts)
- + Woollen socks
- + Sandshoes/sneakers (that can get muddy)
- + Sandals for water activities
- + Dress shoes (for Pathfinder Dress Uniform)

Please note that jandals/thongs/flip flops and bare feet are considered unsafe by the Committee and are inappropriate at the Camporee except in the sub-camp area.

Please bring a pleasant happy spirit and a desire to meet new people, challenge yourself and grow closer to God.



BUDDY CLUB HONOUR

If you hope to participate in the Buddy Club Honour **you must register your**

interest – even if you have already made your own arrangements to ‘Buddy up’. Although still under development, we can tell you the good news that both clubs participating in this will receive the Buddy Club Honour. Later in the year the workbook will be sent out with the requirements to be done prior to Camporee as well as during Camporee. Marcelle is the Buddy Club Honour liaison and will assist the clubs in buddying up and explaining the honour requirements. Please note while we will do our best to find you a Buddy Club, there is no guarantee we will be successful. Contact Marcelle for enquiries about this Honour.
